

How will the School keep me informed about how my child is doing?

The School aims to work in partnership with parents and carers. We do so by:

- ❖ Keeping parents and carers informed and giving support during assessment and any related decision-making process about SEND provision
- ❖ Working effectively with all other agencies supporting children and their parents or carers
- ❖ Giving parents and carers opportunities to play an active and valued role in their child's education - meetings at least termly in the form of parent consultations/IEP meetings
- ❖ Making parents and carers feel welcome
- ❖ Ensuring all parents and carers have appropriate communication aids and access arrangements
- ❖ Direct contact with the SENCO
- ❖ Providing all information in an accessible way
- ❖ Encouraging parents and carers to inform school of any difficulties they perceive their child may be having or other needs the child may have which need addressing
- ❖ Instilling confidence that the school will listen and act appropriately
- ❖ Focusing on the child's strengths as well as areas of additional need
- ❖ Allowing parents and carers opportunities to discuss ways in which they and the School can help their child
- ❖ Agreeing targets for the child

- ❖ Making parents and carers aware of the DIASS - Derbyshire, Information, Advice and Support Service (Formerly Parent Partnership) services and any other support services they could access (see Derbyshire's Local Offer)
