Extend opportunities for promoting positive images and messages around equality e.g. disability, race.
3	To improve access for those who are disabled to our school building and grounds.	Ensure any additional work in school takes into account equal opportunity for all. Ensure that all external pathways are kept clear and are wide enough. Ensure that people with disabilities are planned for when inviting the wider community into school.
