

How accessible is the School environment?

Hasland Junior School is a relatively new single storey building and all areas are accessible. The playground is accessed by steps and a ramp and the garden and wooded area have level pathways.

In order to ensure those with sight impairment can move safely throughout the School, decorating has been done after consultation with the Service for the Visually Impaired.

There are accessible toilets and separate changing facilities are available.

The equipment used in school is accessible to all pupils regardless of need.
