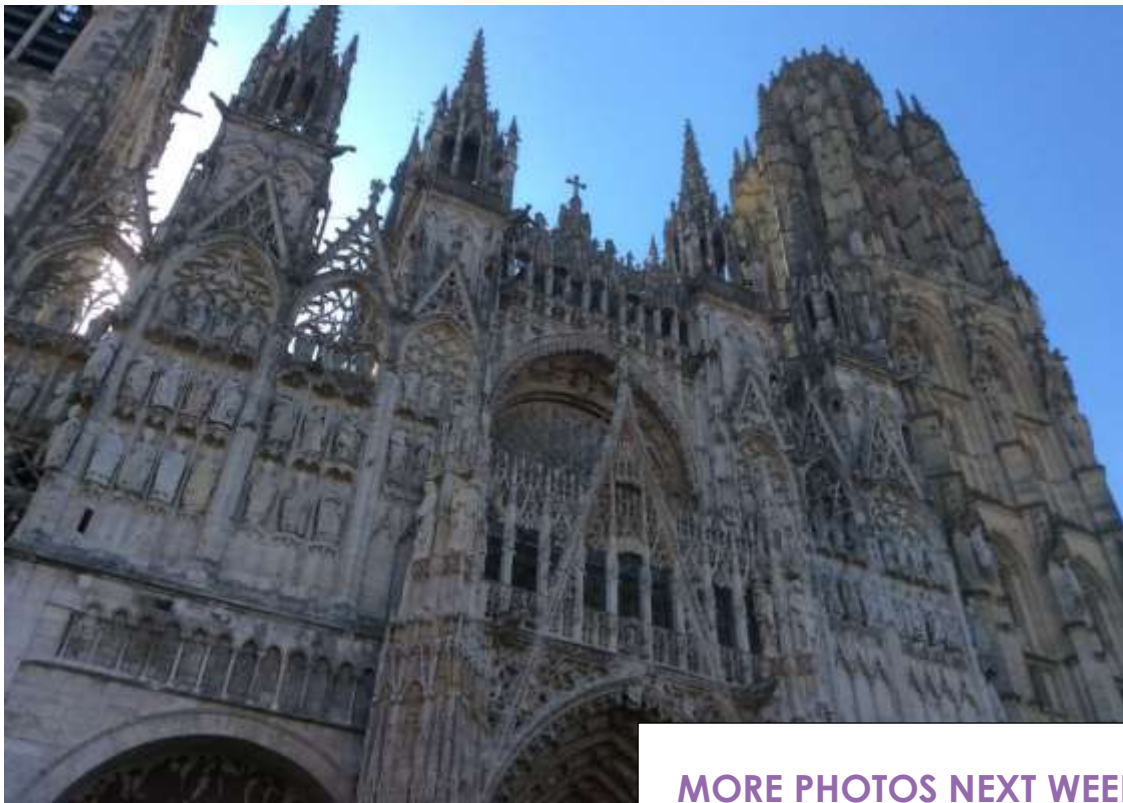
# Year 6 visit to France 2018
