ART DAY - Tuesday 23rd January 2018



Year 3: Today gave Year 3 children the opportunity to experiment with colour. Recognising primary colours and how they are mixed to create secondary and different shades of colour. Having learned the different parts of a brush they used brush strokes and colour mixing to paint a scene of a non-active volcano.



Year 4: Claude Monet (1840 - 1926) was the inspiration for Year 4's Art Day. They investigated his artwork and the idea of Impressionism. Using shades of green and blue they created a water colour in the style of Monet's painting of Water Lilies. The children also had the opportunity to use clay to construct from observation a water lily.

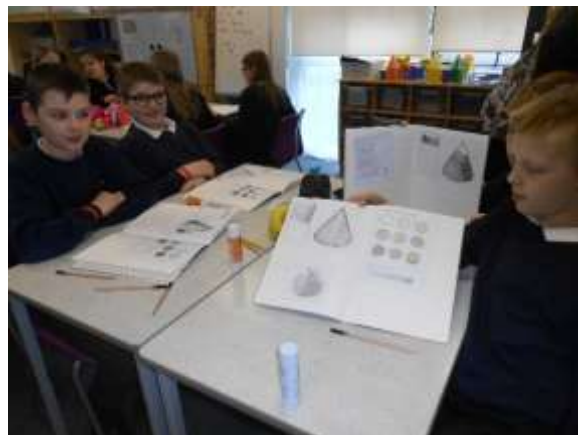


Year 5: Andy Warhol pop art was the theme in Year 5. Looking at pop culture they used tracing paper to create an image which was then painted in bold, bright colours. They developed skills to create an even movement when using a paintbrush, ensuring that the bristles pulled in the same direction.

Year 6: Exploring composition, perspective and tones in Still Life Art was how Year 6 engaged themselves on Art Day. Using pencil, charcoal and coloured pastels to draw shapes such as cones and spheres to demonstrate light and shade. Motivated by some of the 20th century Still Life artists they drew a Still Life of fruit using hatching, cross hatching and tonal shades of light and dark.
