## Safeguarding: New school gate opening/closing times

As you will be aware, the school takes the safety and wellbeing of the children very seriously and to improve this further, the governors have decided to make some changes to the access arrangements at the school.

When the children return to school on **Monday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2019**, the gate from The Green and the gate accessing the playground from the turning circle will remain **closed until 8.30 am**. (Can I remind you at this point that children should not be on the playground until **8.45 am** at the earliest).

At home time, the gate from The Green will open at **3.15 pm** giving people collecting children access to the jitty. The gate at the end of the jitty, giving access to the playground, will remain locked until **3.25 pm**. The gate accessing the playground from the turning circle will also remain closed until **3.25 pm**.



**Both the gate leading onto The Green AND the gate leading onto the path by the turning circle, will now be locked at 3.40 pm.** This will mean that any parents or carers collecting children from after school clubs will now have to access the site through Mansfield Road or Broomfield Avenue entrances and come to the main school entrance by the office.

Children walking home alone from after school clubs will also have to leave through the main entrance and turn left to go through the Mansfield Road gate OR turn right and go through the Broomfield Avenue entrance.

**This will also mean that any child attending Breakfast Club will now need to access school through the main entrance.**

We thank you in anticipation for your cooperation and understanding in this matter.

## JOB VACANCY

The governors are looking to employ two adults who can help us monitor the school gates and control who has access to and from the playground.

An advert has been placed on the Derbyshire website which asks people to apply for the following roles:

- 2 adults with clear DBS checks.
- Term time only
- Permanent contracts
- Required **8.30am to 9.00am AND 3.25pm to 3.40pm DAILY**
- Salary would be approximately £1436 per annum.  
(approximately £120 per month).
- Appointed people who have children at the school would be given a FREE place at Breakfast Club for their child.

This position would be great for parents or carers who could do this job when they collect their children from school.
