Mr Stringer aka 'Birdman' in Daring Rescue!

Mr. Stringer was asked a few weeks ago to talk about what he does in the local community. It may seem obvious being a Headteacher. But no two days are the same when working in a school.



Rescuing a Harris Hawk from a tree, on school grounds, is not usually part of a Headteacher's job description.

But, that is exactly what he did.

An 'eagle-eyed' parent noticed the bird's flying leash had become entangled around a branch, preventing the bird from flying away.

Armed with a ladder, kindly provided by Hasland Hall Community School, Mr. Stringer scaled the tree, lopped off the offending branch and brought the bird down safely from the tree.

Mr Mills a local Falconry expert, was on hand to ensure that the Harris Hawk was cared for and we are pleased to report that Mr Mills was able to reunite the rescued bird with its owner who lives locally.

Dog Free Zone:

Parking on Mansfield Road:

We would ask parents to be careful when parking on Mansfield Road. The School Crossing Patrol Service have notified us of a number of 'near misses' near the pedestrian crossing. Vehicles parked near or on the zig zag lines obscure vision of other drivers and results in hazardous overtaking manoeuvres.



As a result, Mansfield Road is now being monitored by the School Crossing Patrol Service.
