ADMISSIONS POLICY

Derbyshire County Council - the Local Authority - co-ordinates the admissions to all Derbyshire Primary, Infant and Junior Schools. Essentially the Authority acts as a clearing house for all admissions and enables parents/carers to express a preference for one, two or three schools and to place these preferences in rank order.

Parents/carers must make their application via Derbyshire County Council at www.derbyshire.gov.uk/admissions. If you cannot access the internet you can Call Derbyshire on 01629 533190 for their staff to take your application details.

We are currently an oversubscribed school and all in-year applications have been refused over the last year. You do have the right to appeal against the decision and information about how to appeal is included in the decision notification you receive from Derbyshire County Council.

Our school operates 12 classes (3 single aged classes per year group).

It is not the school's policy to move children from one class to another at the request of parents.

The school is 12 years old and was built to accommodate 360 pupils (90 per year group). This was risen to 95 per year group by Derbyshire County Council. Our Governors have now set a limit on this as we struggle for space due to the numbers we have.
