Dress Code.

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you know, our school has an agreed dress code.

This is included in our school brochure and has been shared with all parents and carers as part of their child's transfer to our school. Therefore, as parents and carers, you have all 'signed up to this' when you chose Hasland Junior as your preferred school.

I have copied below the relevant sections from our brochure.

School Uniform/ Appearance

We have a school uniform and we hope that all parents will ensure their children are dressed accordingly.

- Navy sweatshirt/sweat-cardigan /fleece (with or without the school logo Plain white polo shirt
- School wear trousers, skirts/pinafore dress in grey or black
- School shoes
- In summer blue and white school wear dresses checked/striped or school wear shorts in grey or black may be worn

Nail varnish is not appropriate and should not be worn in school.

We also ask that parents do not allow their child to dye their hair unnatural colours as this does not fit in with the uniform policy.

Jewellery Policy

We ask that children do not wear jewellery to school, but if they do, this should be limited to a watch and simple stud earrings. Necklaces and bracelets should not be worn.



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We have noticed recently that some children are coming to school dressed in a way that does not reflect this dress code.

Could I ask therefore, that you support the school in this policy and ensure that your child comes to school dressed appropriately, without nail varnish, minus excessive jewellery and with natural hair colours.
