

What training has staff supporting pupils with SEND had?

The SENCO is available to support class teachers in planning for pupils with SEND.

The School provides training and support to enable all staff to improve teaching and learning of pupils, including those with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities.

Teachers and teaching assistants have a range of expertise of specialised areas including autism, pastoral care, behaviour management, supporting children with dyslexia, moving and handling, and Makaton.

The School accesses a variety of services to ensure that the skills of the staff match the needs of the current pupils. In house training is given by SSSEN and staff regularly attends their training sessions out of school.
